Admissions Procedures:

1. Tour of the school.
2. Submit your application with fee
3. Informal family interview with class teacher(s)
4. You will be informed of your child's admission status within one week of your interview
5. Pledge review meeting to confirm tuition and pledge commitments
6. Completed and signed tuition contract, immunization records, and emergency contact forms are required prior to enrollment
7. A ten percent tuition payment is required prior to the first day of school

Admissions Policy:
